## Wright Brothers Historic Tour

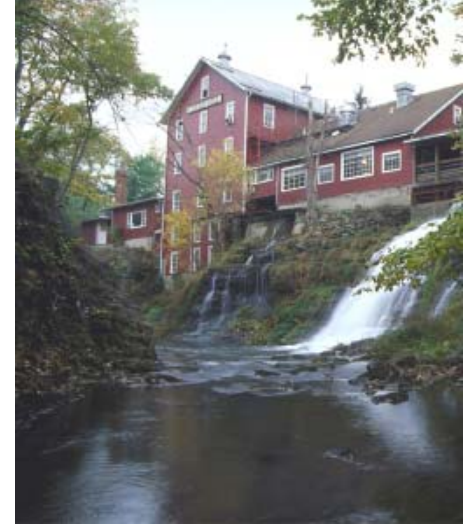

**Huffman Prairie Flying Field & Interpretive Center** – It was here that the Wright Brothers learned how to fly. See where the brothers successfully mastered the mechanics of controlled, powered, and heavier than air flight. Visit the new Interpretive Center. A National Park Ranger will bring history to life! Free Admission.

**Wright Memorial** – This historic memorial overlooks Huffman Prairie where Orville and Wilbur Wright flew their experimental airplanes and the Wright Company conducted a flying school. Free Admission

**Carillon Historical Park** – Showcases our rich heritage of creativity, invention and milestones of innovation that changed the nation and the world. Among the 24 attractions at this unique 65-acre outdoor museum is the original 1905 Wright Flyer III, the world's first practical airplane. This airplane made history over Huffman field in Greene County.



## Greene County Scenic Tour

**Village of Yellow Springs** – Stop in the eclectic village of homemade textiles, pottery and art of all kinds. It's unique shops and business are as interesting as its residents. It's an artist Mecca.

**Lunch at Historic Clifton Mill** – The drive past Glen Helen, John Bryan State Park and Clifton Gorge and all the more reason to venture out to see one of the oldest working water mills in the country. Watch as they grind meal still used today in their giant pancakes. Dine at the Millrace Restaurant overlooking the water and one of 5 historic covered bridges. It's a charming throw back to another era.

**Young's Jersey Dairy** – A family owned and operated dairy farm the Youngs have been widely know for their high butterfat 'yummy' ice cream. Stop and pet the animals, play a quick round of miniature golf or simply enjoy the old farm setting in this beautiful country environment. Visit one of two gift shops on the premises.
